INTRODUCTION

In today's reading, we see Mary who literally is bringing Jesus to her cousin, Elizabeth. She carries him in her womb and speaks the words of the first disciple and missionaries, words which are the beginning of all belief: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior." This is Mary's most beautiful prayer, a statement of her praise and hope. We can only imagine what other travels Mary took in the course of her life. All of us, like Mary, are on a journey. All of us are traveling to places we may not understand, to destinations we cannot see. But we ask Mary to help guide us on our way. Help us Lord to hear Your Word and fulfill Your holy will. We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord.

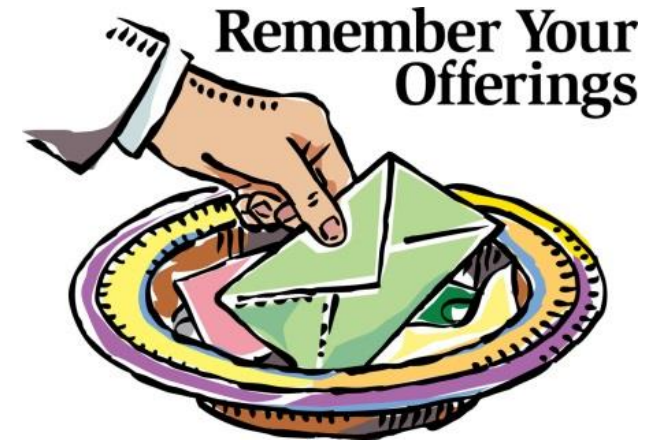


HOLY CROSS PARISH DAILY PRAYER CHAIN
